What Is A Zoning By-law?

A Zoning By-law regulates the use of land and buildings. It provides specific standards for how development and construction can occur on a property. It is an important regulatory tool that contributes to the built form and function of the City. The *Planning Act* requires municipalities to update its Zoning By-law within three years of a new Official Plan coming into effect.

Project Purpose:

- To implement the Official Plan (VOP 2010) in accordance with provincial legislation.
- To create a more progressive Zoning By-law that reflects the City's transformation into a vibrant and sustainable place.
- To respond to emerging urban issues and contemporary urban development trends.
